

74th Street NE & White Ivy Place Reconstruction

Cedar Rapids, Iowa

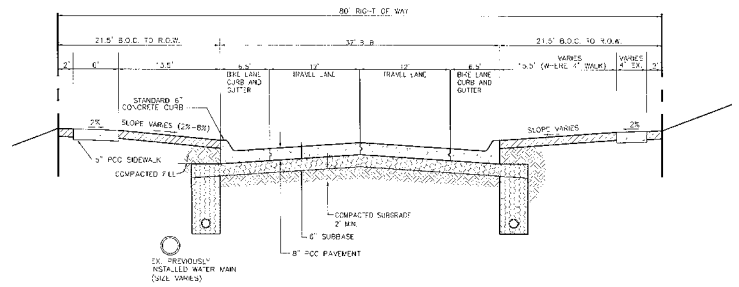


Project Description:

This project consisted of reconstructing 2,200 LF of a rural seal coat section of 74th Street to an urban section with shared use bike lanes. Wetland mitigation and conveyance of runoff was addressed with the project. There was close interaction with a development on the north side of the street. Some costs were assessed to the property owners and there were public meetings to obtain input from the residents. One of the challenges was tying into existing sidewalk on the south side of the street and obtaining adequate clearances for storm sewers. A number of utilities needed to be relocated and coordination with private utility companies was critical to maintaining the project schedule.

Status:

Completed March 2012 with a construction cost of \$828 K and initial estimate of \$990 K

- Pavement reconstruction work in an existing neighborhood
- Wetland delineation and mitigation
- Coordination with private utilities and property owners
- Improved site drainage
